



Coloured Breed Highlights - December 2011 -

Steady Progress for the Ayrshire Breed

With a relatively quiet proof run, St Clement Fabio-ET (B-Jurist x Journalist) is the highest young sire graduate this round, arriving at #18 LPI (#8 Milk, tied #8 Fat). Ayr Bay Captain (Poker x Bonnie Brae Jaye) also creates interest, debuting at #27 LPI (#6 Conformation) and the third highest newcomer is Lagace Don Juan (Bermudes x Lorenzo) at #33 LPI. The Top 10 LPI list is still led by Peterslund but his son out of Hautpre Pardner Korane, namely Hautpre Kansas, takes #2 LPI as he edges by Orraryd (#3 LPI). Kellcrest Landscape-ET (Conn x B Jurist) gains 164 LPI points and jumps from #9 to #6 LPI, immediately following B Jurist (#4) and T-Bruno (#5). The rest of the new Top 10 LPI list includes Jelyca Oblique (#7), Palmyra Jerry Bendig-ET (#8), Kildare Jupiter-ET (#9), and Kildare Percy-ET (#10 LPI).

Des Fleurs Poker Partenaire-ET continues her march up the list to become the new breed leader at #1 LPI this round. She is followed by two familiar names with Lagace BJ Model at #2 LPI (#9 Milk, tied #3 Fat, tied #1 Protein) and Kamouraska Judi Uby-ET at #3 LPI (tied #4 Protein). The Top 10 LPI list is completed by Kamouraska Peterslund Ugenie-ET (#4 LPI), Kildare Patsy B-Justice-ET (#5), Des Fleurs Poker Partie-ET (#6 LPI, full sister to Partenaire), Des Fleurs Jurist Parfette (#7 LPI, dam of Partenaire, Partie and Pascale), Kamouraska Peterslund Ruby (#8 LPI, dam of Uby and full sister to Ugenie), Des Fleurs Poker Pascale-ET (#9 from #18 LPI), and Kellcrest Lea (#10 LPI). The two highest newly indexed cows this round are both Poker daughters, namely Kellcrest Sydney (#12 LPI, daughter of Lea) and Lashburn Jevette-ET (#13 LPI, daughter of Kildare Patsy B-Justy-ET at #15 LPI).

Solid Top Rankings in the Jersey Breed

All three Top 10 LPI newcomers last round remain among this elite group, including Sunset Canyon Maximus-ET (Lemvig x Haug) creeping up from #6 to #3 LPI, landing behind the breed leading duo of Q Impuls (#1 LPI) and Legacy (#2 LPI). The two others, namely Unique VS Habit (Rocket x Remake) and Lencrest I Pod-ET (latola x Parade), take #6 LPI and #9 LPI, respectively. The Top 10 LPI list is completed by Dice (#4), latola (#5), Connection (#7), Kyros (#8) and Bridon Swat (#10 LPI, Sultan x Remake). Three young sire graduates penetrate the Top 30 LPI list this round. They are headed by Verdurelea Resolution (Big Time x Hallmark) at #14 LPI but also include La Presentation Gap (latola x Hallmark) at #26 LPI and SR Nathan Pro-P (polled, Nathan x Jace) at #28 LPI.

Hautpre Legacy Fate becomes the new #1 GLPI cow for Jerseys after nudging passed the former leader, Bona Legacy Ricky ET (#2 GLPI). Gabys Blair Antiqua-ET and Woodland Sultan Jenn 15S stay firm at #3 and #5 GLPI, respectively, surrounding Luchanel Select LB Sable ET at #4 GLPI (#1 Protein) after gaining 166 LPI points from #13 spot. Completing the Top 10 GLPI list this round are Lencrest Gold Belle-ET (#6, daughter of Lencrest Declo Belle), Sunset Canyon Mili Apple ET (#7, Militia x Lemvig), Unique Habit J Lo (#8, Habit x Treaty), Lone Pine latola Diorissima (#9, latola x Giller) and Hautpre Sultan France-ET (#10 GLPI, daughter of Hautpre Fusion Francia). Valleystream Remake Honey-ET is the highest new cow on the GLPI list at #14 after being recently genotyped. The highest cow with their first official LPI without genomics is Du Fjord Senior Bellissima at #8 on the Top LPI candidate list for genotyping, who is a daughter of Lencrest Fprize Belle.

Interesting Results for Brown Swiss Breed

Although Sun-Made Vigor-ET gains 294 LPI points and is boosted from #4 to #2 LPI this round, Blessing Prophet Ransom remains firm as breed leader holding on to #1 LPI. Vigor's upward move forces Sun-Made Gar Bro Pronto-ET and Quincy Even Special down one spot to #3 and #4 LPI, respectively. Some reshuffling takes place among those completing the Top 10 LPI list, which now include Payoff, Even, Ferrari, Goldmine, Wagor and Scipio, in that order. Three bulls with their first official LPI infiltrate the Top 25 LPI list this round. They include Triangle Acres Poet-ET (Beamer x Emerald) as a young sire graduate at #13 LPI (tied #4 Fat, #6 Protein), Kruses Big T Fastbreak-ET (Big Time x Jade) at #14 LPI (tied #4 Conformation) and Top Acres Power Surge (Jet Power x Ensign) at #24 LPI (#7 Milk, #9 Protein). For Brown Swiss cows, a Fastbreak daughter, Anfield FB Jane's Emma ET, stays solidly at #1 LPI. Still at #2 LPI is Gubelman Draft Deana but she is now followed by her maternal sister, Gubelman Vigor Donna, at #3 LPI (dam is Gubelman Dominate Destiny). The Top 5 LPI list is rounded off by Gubelman Pronto Dorissa at #4 LPI (daughter of brood cow Gubelman Gordon Dora) and Gubelman Scipio Lisa at #5 LPI. The highest newly indexed cow this round is Gubelman Vigor Dolphin at #11 LPI.

“Lewis” and Daughters Top Guernsey LPI Lists

Following a short-lived setback last round, Glen Haven Lewis Lana recaptures #1 LPI at 1800 points. Three more Lewis daughters stay solid taking the next three LPI ranks, namely Eby Manor Lewis Secelia (#2), Maplehurst Lewis Brea (#3) and Guernsey View Kit's Ruby (#4). The former breed leader, Maplehurst Aarons Bianca, experiences some slippage but still completes the Top 5 LPI list this round and maintains #1 Fat. The highest newly indexed cow, Maplehurst Spruces Kind, makes an outstanding debut at #10 LPI and is a daughter of Maplehurst Chiller Kiwi at #12 LPI. While the group of breed leading bulls remain unchanged, including Lewis (#1 LPI), Jordan (#2), Double L (#3), Bingo (#4), Warden (#5) and Bolero (#6), it is Sniders Option Aaron-ET (Option x Enhancer) that creates attention as he receives his first official domestic LPI arriving at #7 LPI with #9 Milk, #2 Fat, and tied #7 Protein.

“Simon” Takes the Limelight in the Canadienne Breed

Acton Rubis Simon ET (Rubis x Energika) shines brightly as a young sire graduate arriving at #3 LPI, #1 Conformation at +14 and tied at #7 Protein. Other bulls in the Top 5 LPI include Expo (#1), Nectar (#2), Mister (#4) and Epi (#5). For cows, the breed leaders experience little change still led by Monbriant Expo Fleurette at #1 LPI, followed by Amandes Expo Justice (#2), Acton Energika Rosie 3R ET (#3), Acton Epi Nita (#4) and De Tilly Oscar Princesse ET (#5).

Milking Shorthorn Breed Welcomes Top LPI Arrivals

Oceanbrae Diamond Jack ET becomes a welcome addition appearing at #6 LPI with a balance of production and type. He lands immediately behind his sire, Innisfail Prince of Diamonds (“POD”) at #5 LPI. Breed leaders stay firm led by Logic (#1 LPI), B Jurist (#2), Lance (#3), and Frolic (#4). For cows, Logic daughters continue to rule with Headacher Logic Doris at #1 LPI (#1 Conformation) and Lands-Brook Chardonnay ET Exp at #2 LPI. Oceanbrae Jurist Thyme ET (daughter of Oceanbrae Pepper 2nd) is the highest newly indexed cow this round and makes an outstanding debut taking #3 LPI (#1 Fat), ahead of Knoxdale Elsa (#4) and Kulp-Gen Jurist Angel Exp-ET (#5).
