

Coloured Breed Highlights - August 2013 -

First "Jupiter" Sons Penetrate Top 10 LPI for Ayrshires!

The first two progeny proven sons of Kildare Jupiter (#26 LPI) enter the centre stage spotlight amongst the Top 10 LPI sires. Kamouraska Decaf-ET (dam is Kamouraska Peterslund Ruby) arrives at #2 LPI (#4 Milk, tied #5 Fat, tied #4 Protein), behind Orraryd as the LPI leader and just ahead of his maternal brother Kamouraska Rockstar (#3 LPI, by Modem). The second Jupiter son off to a great start is D'Albanel Jurassic at #9 LPI (dam is Marilie Copper Mylla), who is a maternal brother to D'Albanel Marlow-ET (by Normandin) at #6 LPI and tied at #9 Conformation with +12. Other previous Top 10 LPI sires staying relatively stable include Peterslund (#4 LPI), Hautpre Kansas (#5 LPI, up from #10), T-Bruno (#7 LPI), B Jurist (#8 LPI) and Jelyca Oblique at #10 LPI. In addition to Decaf and Jurassic, four other young sire graduates enter the Top 20 LPI list this round. These include La Sapiniere Gideo at #13 LPI, who is the first proven son of Orraryd in Canada with Janid Gigi as his dam; Kellcrest Longrun-ET at #16 LPI (Poker x Kellcrest Lea), who is a maternal brother to Landscape at #11 LPI: La Sapiniere Cacyked at #18 LPI, who is the first proven son of Edmour; and Palmyra Bet On Me-ET at #20 LPI (Poker x Palmyra Jerry Bethany). The highest newcomer last round, namely Des Fleurs Perfect-ET (Poker x B Jurist), loses some ground for both production and type and lands at #14 LPI from the #3 spot.

Two daughters of Kamouraska Peterslund Ruby (#2 LPI), namely Kamouraska Orra Xuby (#1 LPI by Orraryd) and Kamouraska Jupi Uby-ET (#3 LPI by Jupiter), sandwich their dam and hold firm as the breed leading trio again this round. The two highest newly indexed cows this round enter the Top 10 LPI list with Glen Malcolm Orra Mikie taking #5 LPI (#3 Protein) and Ayr-Phoe O Zana debuting at #8 LPI. These two Orraryd daughters follow a paternal sister, Ramco Orraryd Bess, who stays solid at #4 LPI. The remaining Top 10 LPI cows include Kamouraska Poker Rubis-ET (#6 LPI), Visserdale Sunrise-ET (#7) and Kamouraska Poker Wilhelmina (#9 LPI, maternal sister to Ruby), as well as Kamouraska Peterslund Tunamie (maternal sister to Ruby) and Roi Reality Fancy who are tied at #10 LPI. In total, over one-third of the current Top 400 LPI cows are sired by Poker (21.75%) or Orraryd (12.5%).

Five Bulls with their First Domestic LPI Infiltrate the Top 20 List in Jerseys

This round of Jersey evaluations sees three US-proven sires get an official LPI among the breed leaders as well as two young sire graduates entering the Top 20 LPI list. Tollenaars Impuls Legal 233-ET (Impuls x Lemvig) ranks #3 with his first domestic LPI while Ahlem Lemvig Abe-ET (Lemvig x Sky Line) and Galaxies Celebrity-ET (Jace x Declo) take #8 and #11 LPI positions, respectively. For the highest young sire graduates, Lencrest Glasgow-ET (1st proven son of Seville) and Hometown On The Money (1st proven son of On Time) arrive at #17 and #18 LPI, respectively. Although Q Impuls maintains his reign at #1 LPI, the highest newcomer from last round, Gillard Pancho ET (Legacy x Centurion), gains 100 LPI points to take the #2 LPI spot. The Top 10 LPI list is completed by Rocha Iatola Walker-ET (#4), Sunset Canyon Dice-ET (#5), Sunset Canyon Maximus-ET (#6), SC Gold Dust Paramount Iatola-ET (#7), Altramont MH Fantom (#9) and Sunset Canyon Kyros at #10 LPI.

As Reyla Impuls Chardonnay (Impuls x Knock-Out) continues her climb up the LPI ladder she achieves the summit this round as the new #1 GLPI cow. Stornaway Stone Flora (Stone x latola) also makes a gain from #5 to #2 GLPI. A trio of newly indexed cows this round take the next three LPI rankings with Bona Renegade Coraline at #3 LPI (Renegade x Tyler), followed by two daughters of Gabys Blair Aruba ET, namely Hometown N Feature Attraction (by Navara) and Gabys Legal Adrianna-ET (by Legal) at #4 and #5 LPI. The Top 10 GLPI cow list is completed by Rexlea Valentino Item (#6), Rexlea On Time Imperial (#7), Lencrest Gold Belle-ET (#8), Missiska Renegade Veda (#9, 4th highest newly indexed cow) and Hautpre Legacy Fate at #10 GLPI.

"Boumatic" Receives First Official Domestic LPI in the Brown Swiss Breed

After first being proven in the United States, Top Acres Boumatic-ET (Dalton x Prelude) debuts at #5 LPI (#8 Milk, #5 Fat, #8 Protein) with his first official domestic LPI. Leading the pack for LPI this round are Blessing Prophet Ransom (#1 LPI, #2 Milk), Olson Millenium-ET (#2 LPI, tied #5 Protein), Triangles Acres PO Payoff ET (#3 LPI, #1 Milk, #1 Protein) and Triangle Acres Poet ET (#4 LPI, #1 Fat, #2 Protein). Noteworthy young sire graduates include Sun-Made GB Vital Sign-ET (Zeus x President) at #17 LPI and Top Acres JCS Shebang (Wonderment x Starbuck) at #21 LPI and tied at #5 Conformation with +10. Also of interest is the first official domestic proof for the Swiss-proven sire, Jolahofs Polo Jongleur-ET (Polo x Starbuck), who becomes the new breed leader for Conformation at +13 and takes #49 LPI. Gubelman Juhus Dazzel continues to lead the list of top LPI cows. Sandwiched between Dazzel and her dam, Gubelman Pronto Dorissa (#3 LPI), is Swiss Dream Wonder Ursula as she jumps from #5 to #2 LPI this round. Other Top 5 LPI cows are Anfield FB Jane's Emma ET (#4) and Gubelman Juhus Crystal at #5 LPI. The highest newly indexed cow this round is Swisslane Vigor Liessa at #9 LPI. Following her sire, Jongleur, there is also a new #1 Conformation cow as Brown Heaven J Butterfly gets her first genetic evaluation with +14.

All is Quiet on the Guernsey Front

With all bulls on the previous Top 50 LPI list changing less than 100 LPI points, little change occurs among the top rankings. Although Lewis remains at #1 LPI, he is followed this round by Double L (#2), Bingo (#3), Jordan (#4) and Warden (#5 LPI). The sole young sire graduate, Adams Creek Regal Morey (Regal x Magician), lands at #41 LPI. For cows, those among the Top 10 LPI remain the same group with only minor reshuffling. Glen Haven Lewis Lana (#1) and Maplehurst Aarons Bianca (#2) remain the breed leaders for LPI, now followed by Lindrian Aaron Penny One, Maplehurst Warden Bianca (dam of Aarons Bianca) and Guernsey View Tina's Winnie, respectively. The highest newly indexed cow this round is Guernsey View Reta's Export (Grumpy x Mr America) at #24 LPI.

Status Quo for the Canadienne Breed

As Expo and Nectar remain firm at #1 and #2 LPI, respectively, minor changes result in Telethon (#3), Simon (#4) and Mister (#5) taking the following positions. Brunet Frontenac Kodiac receives his first official LPI at #15 with below average type and production. On the cow side, the trio of Monbriant Expo Fleurette (#1), Acton Energika Rosie 3R ET (#2) and Acton Expo Sara (#3) stay solid and are now followed by Clerjoye Expo Rose 36B 50.0 (#4 from #8 LPI) and Amandes Expo Justice at #5 LPI. This round's highest newly indexed cow is Amandes Telethon Xara-ET at #28 LPI.

Four Newcomers Enter the Top 15 LPI in Milking Shorthorns

After receiving their first official production proof last round, Kulp-Gen Jurist Ace ET (B Jurist x Derek) and Kulp-Gen OK Acdmy Adam-P ET (OK Academy x Derek, maternal brother to Ace) do not disappoint with both reaching +8 Conformation (tied at #3) and achieving #2 LPI and #11 LPI, respectively. Cate's Tangerines Perles Titan (Peerless x Rebel 9th) also creates interest with his debut at #8 LPI combined with #1 Milk, #3 Protein and tied at #9 Fat. A fourth newly proven sire is Vinra Bar-D Famous-Twin (Now You See x Frost), who arrives at #15 LPI. Other LPI leaders include B Jurist (#1), Clarefield Mocha (#3), GMC Rebel Logic ET (#4), Vinra Frost Red (#5) and Oceanbrae Logic's Plato, who lands at #6 LPI after losing 4 points for Conformation. Maternal sister to Ace and Adam-P, namely Kulp-Gen Jurist Angel EXP-ET E, still reigns as the #1 LPI cow with her daughter, Lady Grove Mocha Angeline ET not far behind at #3 LPI, and her maternal sister, Koopycrest Mocha Ali Apple ET at #4 LPI. With Brook Chardonnay ET EXP also staying firm at #2 LPI, the Top 5 LPI list is completed by the highest newly indexed cow this round, namely Oceanbrae Logic Feather ET (#5), while her full sister, Oceanbrae Logic Fawn ET, is the second highest tied at #8 LPI.
