

"Seasidebloom" Regains Top Honours Among Brown Swiss Bulls

Although the group of sires among the Top 5 LPI are exactly the same as last April, it is Lime Rock Seasidebloom that regains the throne at #1 LPI (#1 Milk, tied #4 Fat, #2 Protein) as Huray loses ground and slips to #2 LPI (#2 Milk, #1 Fat, #1 Protein). With only minor reshuffling, they are now followed by Shiloh Brookings Cadence ET (#3 LPI, #9 Milk, tied #4 Fat, #3 Protein, tied #9 Conformation), Lime Rock Toledo (#4 LPI, #3 Fat, tied #5 Protein) and Scherma Blooming Biver (#5 LPI, #8 Fat, tied #5 Protein, tied #5 Conformation). The US-proven sire, Reads Driver Kannon (Driver x Kilo Var) gets his first Canadian progeny proof and arrives at #6 LPI (#2 Fat, #8 Protein). Also noteworthy is R N R Supreme Lebron (Supreme x Legacy), who was also originally proven in the United States and now achieves official status domestically and is tied at #1 Conformation.

On the cow side, the Top 5 GLPI list experiences very little change with each cow changing less than 50 LPI points. The duo of Gubelman Juhus Crystal (#2 Fat, #2 Protein) and Nor Bella Paul Eve (#1 Fat, tied #10 Protein, tied #2 Conformation) maintain their placings at #1 and #2 GLPI, respectively. After being the highest newly index cow in April, Gubelman Biver Kendra manages to climb up a notch to #3 GLPI, ahead of Charluson Cadence Dalida (#4 GLPI, #2 Milk, #4 Fat, tied #4 Protein). Gubelman SSB Devon P also climbs a step to round off the Top 5 GLPI list in #5 position (#3 Milk, #1 Protein). Seasidebloom also has success this round by siring the highest newly indexed cow, Campagnard Seasidebloom Carla (dam is R Hart Vigor Carly), at #9 GLPI.

Two Interesting Sires Achieve Success in Milking Shorthorn

Lynmark St Clare, who is a Mocha son out of Lynmark NS Clarica, is newly proven this round with interesting results as he debuts at #6 LPI (tied #4 Conformation). Right behind him, at #7 LPI, is Kundes Golden Logic Adventure (Logic x B Jurist, tied #1 Fat, #10 Conformation), who receives his first official proof in Canada after originally being proven in the United States. The group of Top 5 LPI remains the same with minor re-ranking, including Treeton Pingerly (#1 for LPI, Milk, Protein and Conformation, #4 Fat), B Jurist (#2 LPI, #3 Milk, #1 Fat, #2 Protein), Oceanbrae Ironman-P ET (#3 LPI, tied #6 Fat, tied #8 Protein, tied #8 Conformation), Kulp-Gen Jurist Ace-ET (#4 LPI, #3 Fat, tied #6 Protein) and Lady Grove Conrad (#5 LPI, tied #8 Fat, tied #8 Conformation).

Although none of the breed leading cows change by more than 80 LPI points, some re-ordering among the top LPI list is seen this round. The one cow that doesn't change rank is the overall LPI leader, Kulp-Gen Jurist Angel EXP-ET, as she stays firm at #1 for LPI, Fat and Protein. Three cows move up the ranks including Lady Grove TP Courtney (from #4 to #2 LPI), Oceanbrae Pingerly Betty (from #8 to #3 LPI, tied #9 Protein, tied #8 Conformation) and Lady Grove TP Lady Nancy 8 (from #5 to #4 LPI, #3 Protein, tied #8 Conformation). Lady Grove BJ Charm (#5 Fat, tied #8 Conformation) only loses 51 LPI points but slips from #2 position in April to complete the list of Top 5 LPI this round. The highest newly indexed cow this August is Oceanbrae TP Lauren at #9 LPI, who is a Pingerly daughter out of Oceanbrae Jurist Layla.

High Stability Seen in the Guernsey Breed

With every breed leading proven sire and cow changing less than 45 points, the lists of Top 5 LPI are very stable this round. One significant change of interest, however, is the switching of the top two LPI sires as Pine Ridge Double L climbs to take #1 LPI (#4 Fat) and his son, Dairyman Double Dawson, slips back to the #2 LPI position (#2 Fat). Trotacre Enhancer Lewis (#3 Milk, tied #2 Protein), Coulee Crest Grumpy Legend (#5 Protein) and Idle Gold E Challenge complete the Top 5 LPI list, in that order.

On the cow side, Eby Manor D L Indy stays solid at #1 LPI (#2 Fat) but it's the two cows that follow her that switch ranking this August. Eby Manor Logo Sylvia continues to make LPI gains and climbs to take #2 spot (#4 Milk, tied #3 Fat, tied #2 Protein), moving ahead of Glen Haven Lewis Lana now at #3 LPI (tied #4 Protein). Lindrian Pamper Bear ET 200 and Guernsey View Urma's Expense both stay firm at #4 and #5 LPI, respectively. The highest newly indexed cow this round is Lindrian Pitty Lightning at #52 LPI, who is a Lightning daughter out of Lindrian Pippy Two.

Two Interesting Sires Achieve LPI Proven Status in the Canadienne Breed

While the longstanding leading sire, Expo, maintains his hold as #1 for LPI, Milk and Protein as well as #2 for Fat, there are two newly proven sires that penetrate the Top 10 LPI list this round. At #2 LPI (#6 Milk, #5 Fat, tied #5 Protein, #2 Conformation), is Beauvoie Sultan Cansey ET, who is a son of the Jersey sire, SHF Centurion Sultan, out of De Tilly Oscar Noisette ET. Also of interest is De Tilly Karate KungFu ET (dam is De Tilly Menhir Tétine) at #9 LPI, who also becomes the new Conformation leader with +10. The Top 5 LPI list is completed by Dr. Terreur (#5 Milk, #1 Fat, #3 Protein), Urluberlu (#3 Fat) and Trad Kid (tied #5 Protein), in that order.

After being the highest newly indexed cow in April, Celebrity Urluberlu Corn gains another 164 points to take over the #1 LPI position (#1 Fat), forcing Amandes Vladimir Adele down to #2 LPI (#3 Fat, tied #1 Protein, #1 Conformation) this round. The next two cows also switch placings as Amandes Vladimir Dancing Queen climbs up one spot to #3 LPI (#3 Milk, tied #1 Protein), ahead of Celebrity Vladimir You, now at #4 LPI (#4 Fat, tied #2 Conformation). Amandes Vladimir Anabelle (tied #5 Protein) does the same and moves from #6 to #5 LPI to complete the list of Top 5 LPI this August. The highest newly indexed cow this round is Amandes Vladimir Déborah at #32 LPI, who is a daughter of Amandes Oscar Arrabella.
