

"Wildcat" Makes Impressive Start at #8 for Both LPI and Pro\$

Ahlem Texas Wildcat 22702-ET is the highest newly proven sire this round and is equally successful for both indexes, landing in #8 position for LPI and Pro\$. Wildcat is the first son of Texas proven in Canada and is a maternal brother to the highest newcomer last round, Ahlem Megatron Windstar-ET (dam is Ahlem Legal Wyn 35647), who now occupies #4 Pro\$ and #6 LPI spots (#2 Fat, #5 Protein). With his high production credentials at #1 Milk and tied for #2 Protein, Glynn Valentino Marcin (dam is Dutch Hollow Jevon Melinda 822-ET) also generates interest as a new sire that is now fully proven, landing at #9 Pro\$ (#35 LPI).

The top four LPI sires this round also achieve Top 10 status for Pro\$, including Golden GDK Vivaldi (#1 LPI and Pro\$, #5 Fat), Hawarden Dimension Pilgrim-ET (#2 LPI, #6 Pro\$, #3 Fat, #9 Protein), River Valley Cece Chrome-ET (#3 LPI, #10 Pro\$) and River Valley Pfennig Perfect Fit (#4 LPI, #5 Pro\$, tied #7 Protein). The Top 10 LPI list is completed with Hawarden Impuls Premier at #5 LPI (#18 Pro\$, maternal brother to Pilgrim), Sunset Canyon Dignitary-ET at #7 LPI (#34 Pro\$), Wilsonview IF Matt-ET at #9 LPI (#17 Pro\$) and DJ Zuma taking #10 LPI position (#32 Pro\$). For Pro\$, the Top 10 list is completed by River Valley PF MegaPower-ET, who grabs #2 Pro\$ (#23 LPI, #6 Fat, tied #10 Protein, maternal brother to Perfect Fit) and moves ahead of his sire, Sunset Canyon Megatron-ET at #3 Pro\$ (tied #15 LPI, #1 Fat, #4 Protein), while Missiska Moore moves up the ranks to take #7 Pro\$ (tied #15 LPI). The second highest newly proven sire for LPI this round is Ahlem Warlock-ET (Vivaldi son out of Ahlem Country Wynola 16456), who lands at #11 LPI (#22 Pro\$). Another noteworthy sire this round is Sugar Grove Valentino Axis (dam is Sugar Grove Restore Addie-ET), who gets his first official production proof in Canada and takes #2 Milk and becomes the new breed leader for Protein.

On the cow side, Lencrest Cocopuff continues to reign at #1 GLPI and #1 Pro\$ (#2 Fat) while some jostling of ranking goes on behind her and two newly indexed cows successfully achieve elite status. The highest of these is Kambro Posterboy Jane 6639 (dam is Kambro Viceroy Jane 6144), who arrives at #3 Pro\$ and #6 GLPI. The second newly indexed cow to make a Top 10 list is Progenesis Pele Barbara ET, who debuts at #6 Pro\$ (#74 GLPI, dam is Sun Valley Magnum Bellita). The four cows between Cocopuff and Jane on the GLPI list all achieve Top 10 status for Pro\$ as well. These include Island Vivaldi Julie who moves up to take #2 GLPI (#7 Pro\$), Redhot Matt Tesla ET at #3 GLPI (#4 Pro\$, tied #1 Conformation), JX Progenesis Jive Dahlia {6}-ET at #4 GLPI (#2 Pro\$, #8 Fat) and Progenesis Trillium at #5 GLPI (#8 Pro\$, #1 Fat). The two other cows that accomplish Top 10 status for both indexes this round are JX Progenesis Imp Helene {6}-ET, who is Dahlia's maternal sister at #5 Pro\$ and #10 GLPI (#5 Fat, #3 Protein), and Redhot Matt Nova ET, who is Tesla's full sister at #8 GLPI and #10 Pro\$. Three other cows manage to enter the Top 10 list for either national index, including Lencrest Premier Coco ET at #7 GLPI (#17 Pro\$, dam of Cocopuff), Guimo Zuma Julia ET (#9 GLPI, #44 Pro\$, dam of Island Vivaldi Julie), and Guimo Nxlevel Irvana at #9 Pro\$ (#95 GLPI).
