



Coloured Breed Highlights - August 2021 -

Brown Swiss Sires Maintain Their Breed Leading Positions

This August release sees no change in breed leaders for LPI, Milk, Fat, Protein and Conformation among Brown Swiss sires. Vassli stays strong in the #1 position for LPI and Fat while also holding on at #2 Milk and #2 Protein. At #2 LPI, Huray still leads at #1 Protein and now occupies #2 position for Fat as well as #3 Milk. Lime Rock Seasidebloom keeps his lead at #1 Milk but is forced down a notch to #4 LPI (tied #5 Fat, #3 Protein) as Shiloh Brookings Cadence ET climbs to take the #3 LPI position (#9 Milk, tied #8 Protein). Assay (Anibal x Payssli) also climbs two steps on the LPI ladder to complete the Top 5 LPI list this round (#5 LPI, #4 for Milk, Fat and Protein). Also worth mentioning is the gain of 141 LPI points experienced by MIR Absolute (Anibal x Huray) after achieving proven status last April, which catapults him from #14 to #6 LPI (#7 Fat, #6 Protein). For Conformation, La Rainbow Bfly Dynamite ETV (Cadence x Durham) gains one point this round to +13 and holds on to his title as breed leader. Joining the group of bulls tied at #4 Conformation is the sole newly proven sire this round, namely the Swiss-born Herrenhof BS Norwin Phil, who makes his debut at #55 LPI (dam is Herrenhof BS Blooming Petunia).

For the second consecutive round, the “Gubelman” prefix takes all of the top five positions on the GLPI list with some minor reranking. To start, Gubelman Juhus Crystal regains her #1 position for both GLPI and Fat while staying firm at #2 Protein. Gubelman Biver Katniss-ET is therefore forced back to #2 GLPI position (tied #7 Conformation, daughter of Gubelman Bookings Katie). She is followed by the pair of Katie’s granddaughters, namely Gubelman Biver Kendra at #3 GLPI and Gubelman Cadence Kasandra in #4 GLPI position. Climbing to take #5 GLPI this August is Gubelman Cadence Dilana (#5 Milk, tied #5 Fat, #1 Protein), who is a maternal sister to Gubelman Biver Diana (#7 GLPI, tied #1 Fat, dam is Gubelman Huray Delinda). Sandwiched between Dilana and Diana is the highest newly indexed cow this round, namely Eloc Glarus Rolo at #6 GLPI, who is a daughter of Eloc Zaristo Roulette by the German sire, Glarus. The second highest newly indexed cow also achieves Top 10 status as Shady Lane Swiss H Aplus (Hilton x Motown) arrives in #10 GLPI position. Two other newly indexed cows make their mark this August as Schweizer Get Lucky Roussette (Get Lucky x Dixon) becomes the new breed leader for Milk and Shady Lane Swiss D Popcorn (Dynamite x Biver) does the same as the new #1 Conformation with +15.

Three Sires Achieve Official LPI Status in Milking Shorthorns

With the group of sires among the Top 5 LPI remaining unchanged, the focus of this August release is the first official LPI results for three sires that were initially progeny proven in United States. The highest of these is North Stars Famous Patriot Exp (Famous x Talent), who arrives at #12 LPI and also lands tied at #6 for Conformation. Two Liriano sons also make their debut as Rovin Bolero Exp takes #23 LPI (#8 Fat) and Eichlers Liriano Blaine Exp now occupies the #48 LPI position. Treeton Pingerly ET still dominates at #1 for LPI, Milk and Conformation and also ranks #2 Protein and #7 Fat. For LPI, he is still followed by B Jurist (#2 LPI, #3 Milk, #1 Fat, #1 Protein) and Kulp-Gen Jurist Ace-ET (#3 LPI, #2 Fat, tied #5 Protein). Swapping places this round and completing the Top 5 LPI list are Lynmark St Clare at #4 LPI (tied #10 Protein, #3 Conformation) and Lady Grove Conrad in #5 LPI position (tied #10 Conformation).

Although Kulp-Gen Jurist Angel EXP-ET also maintains her dominant status at #1 for LPI, Fat and Protein, Oceanbrae Pingerly Berry-ET makes a gallant effort to reach her with a gain of 190 LPI points, which catapults her from #7 to #2 LPI (#2 Fat). This daughter of Oceanbrae Jurist Betty moves ahead of her full sister, Oceanbrae Pingerly Betty, who now occupies #4 LPI position (tied #9 Conformation) and Lady Grove BJ Charm (#3 LPI, #6 Fat) is sandwiched between them. The Top 5 LPI list is rounded off with Lady Grove TP Lady Nancy 8 in #5 spot (tied #8 Protein, tied #9 Conformation). Two newly indexed cows achieve Top 15 LPI status as Oceanbrae Pingerly Camaro grabs #12 LPI (tied #9 Conformation, dam is Lady Grove A. Christie) and Oceanbrae Royal Layton takes the #14 LPI position, who is a daughter of Oceanbrae TP Lauren (#7 LPI, tied #2 Protein).

“Jaguar” Makes an Impressive Debut Among Guernsey Sires

Springhill Jokes Jaguar receives his first official domestic LPI this August and takes centre stage with his arrival in #3 LPI position. This son of Les Jaonnets Caras Conqueror, who was progeny proven in Great Britain, is out of Dix Lee Tiller Joke and is therefore a maternal brother to Springhill Judgment (tied #7 Conformation). Jaguar makes this debut landing behind the breed leading duo of Dairyman Double Dawson (#1 LPI, #2 Fat, tied #10 Protein) and his sire, Pine Ridge Double L (#2 LPI, #3 Fat). Idle Gold E Challenge and Jens Gold C Blue Spruce (tied #9 Fat, tied #8 Protein) complete the Top 5 LPI list this round taking #4 and #5 positions, respectively.

With only five LPI points between them, Lindrian Pamper Bear ET 200 once again is LPI queen among Guernsey cows as she retakes #1 LPI and also leads as the dam of cows among the Top 400 LPI with six daughters. Eby Manor D L Indy slips ever so slightly into #2 LPI spot (#2 Fat) and is now followed by two herd mates, namely Eby Manor Jaguar Faith at #3 LPI and Eby Manor Dawson Rosalyn in #4 LPI position. Another high-ranking Jaguar daughter, Guernsey View Jaguar Erin, completes the Top 5 LPI list this round in #5 position, just ahead of her dam Guernsey View Urma’s Expense at #6 LPI (#4 Fat). The third highest Jaguar daughter for LPI is the top newly indexed cow this August, namely Lindrian Lucky Jaguar at #26 LPI (dam is Lindrian Lucy Python).

“Colonel” Commands Respect in the Canadienne Breed

Amandes Colonel is a welcomed young sire graduate that offers a good balance of production and type. This Faberge son out of Amandes Mister Yelp-Prada ET makes his outstanding debut at #3 LPI, #4 Milk, #5 Fat, tied #3 Protein and tied #5 Conformation. The breed leading duo for LPI remains unchanged, however, as De Tilly Hermes Dr. Terreur stays at #1 LPI (#6 Milk, #1 Fat, #2 Protein) and is still followed by De Tilly Marin Urluberlu (#2 LPI, #2 Fat). While Mon Paradis Trad Kid ET experiences little change, now at #4 LPI (tied #7 Fat, #6 Protein, tied #1 Conformation), it is De Tilly Karate KungFu ET that makes significant gains and climbs the LPI list from #10 position to take #5 LPI (tied #1 Conformation) this August.

For Canadienne cows, the list of Top 5 LPI experiences very little change. Celebrity Urluberlu Corn maintains her envied #1 LPI position (#1 Fat, tied #9 Protein) and is still followed by Amandes Vladimir Adele at #2 LPI (#2 Fat, tied #2 Protein, #1 Conformation), Celebrity Vladamir You at #3 LPI (#5 Fat, tied #2 Conformation), and Amandes Vladamir Fight Club ET in #4 LPI position (#10 Milk, #1 Protein, tied #2 Conformation). Full sister to Fight Club, Amandes Vladamir Anabelle, experiences little LPI change but manages to climb the LPI list from #7 spot to take #5 LPI this round (tied #6 Protein, tied #7 Conformation, dam is Amandes Energika Manie).
